We care about your privacy and are keen to give you a safe and pleasant experience of our website and aim to be as transparent as possible regarding our handling of personal data. This Privacy Policy applies when you visit and browse our website or send a request through our contact forms, or otherwise contact us by email or phone call e.g., regarding request for proposal of our service, meeting us at an event, academic collaborations, open positions. Which data will be processed and how such data will be used will primarily depend on the services used, requested, or contracted.

‘MEDETECT’ or ‘we’ or ‘us’ referred to in this Privacy Policy, is the owner of the website whose registered office is: Medetect AB, Medicon Village, SE-22381 Lund, Sweden. The term ‘you’ refers to the user or viewer of our website.

‘Personal data’ within the meaning of this Privacy Policy are any information that may be related to you i.e., your name, address, email address, phone number, IP address, employer, CV, or any other information that you provide to us, or we collect, when you visit and use our website. ‘Sensitive personal data’ is personal data that reveals race, ethnic origin, sexual orientation, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, trade union membership or that concerns an individual’s health.

Questions, comments, or complaints regarding Medetect's Privacy Policy or data collection and processing practices can be sent to us by email. We may ask for specific information from you to help confirm your identity and secure your right to access your personal data. This is a security measure to ensure that we do not disclose information to unauthorized persons. We try to respond to all legitimate requests within one month.

Your rights in relation to personal data

With us, in accordance with applicable legislation and GDPR, you can exercise your right to:

- Be informed about what information we collect, for what purpose and how we handle it
- Be forgotten, that is, be forgotten. Deleted from e.g., our database
- Correct the information we have about you; in case it is incorrect
- Request the information we hold about you, for your own information, or to use it with another service provider

Medetect will offer individuals the opportunity to choose whether their personal data is (1) to be disclosed to a third party or (2) to be used for a purpose other than the purpose for which it was originally collected or subsequently authorized by the individual. Unless required or authorized by law, Medetect will not process sensitive personal data about individuals for purposes other than those for which the information was originally obtained or subsequently authorized by the individual, unless the individual affirmatively and explicitly consents to the processing ('opt-in'). In some cases, even if an individual opts-out of disclosures of their personal data, Medetect may still disclose such personal data if requested to do so by law, if disclosure is required to be made to law enforcement authorities, if we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to prevent physical harm or financial loss or in connection with an investigation of suspected or actual illegal activity.

What information do we collect and in what way?

Unidentified personal data

Medetect collects anonymous data about the use of our website to improve the customer experience and develop our offer. This information is not at the individual level and includes, among other things, technical data such as the number of visits to the website, length of visits, the user's geographical position, the degree of use of the website's different sections, the type of device used, etc.

Website analytics (Google Analytics 4)

When you visit our website, we may collect aggregated statistics about website usage to improve performance and user experience. If you consent to analytical cookies, we use Google Analytics 4 (Google LLC) for these purposes. GA4 uses cookies such as “_ga” and “_ga_” as described in our cookie declaration and Cookie Policy. You can withdraw your consent at any time via our cookie settings tool.

Identified personal data

Usually, you visit the Medetect website without having to reveal your identity or provide any information about yourself. In some situations, however, we request information from you, such as when you submit a request to us through our contact form, or otherwise contact us by email or phone call. Such requests or contact with us may regard, among other things, more information or request for proposal of our services, meet us at an event, initiate a potential research collaboration with us, or apply to an open position.

Examples of requested personal data are name, e-mail address, phone number, which company or organization you represent, CV's etc.

In addition to the personal data you provide to us directly, we may also get access through data we receive from public registers, if relevant for us to respond to you. We do not process more personal data than is necessary for the purpose, and we always strive to use the least privacy-sensitive information.

For what reason do we process your personal data?

We collect and process primarily the information that you provide us:

- **If you have consented** to personal data processing for specific purposes (e.g., processing of your inquiry, use of data for marketing purposes)
- To comply with our **contractual obligations** or to perform pre-contractual measures upon request. The purposes of data processing depend primarily on your inquiry.
- To **comply with legal requirements** for example, the Accounting Act, or to support an agreement with an individual (such as an employment contracts)

To the extent necessary, we will process your personal data due to **legitimate interests** beyond the actual performance of the agreement with you to protect our rightful interests or those of third parties. For example, we may process your data:

- to assert legal claims or defend legal actions,
- to guarantee IT security and IT operation,
- to analyze and improve use of our website, or
- to use social media plugins.

In addition, when you choose to identify yourself, we also save information about how you interact with our communication channels (website/e-mail) to personalize our offers and target information that we think may be relevant to you. You have the right to unsubscribe from further communication at any time.

Regarding such processing of personal data which is not directly necessary to comply with applicable laws and which does not have another legal ground as described above, we will collect your consent in connection with the retrieval of such personal data, for example health information or other sensitive personal data when inviting to events or seminars.

You may withdraw your consent at any time for such processing as described above. We will then no longer process your personal data or obtain any new data if it is not necessary to fulfill our obligations under a contract or law.

Please note, in connection with using our services you must make available personal data which is necessary for achieving the purpose for which it was collected or which we are required to collect by law. Without that data, we will generally be unable to prepare for or enter into a contract with you.

Who do we share your personal data with?

We do not transfer personal data to third parties in cases other than those expressly stated in this Privacy Policy.

Personal data might be disclosed or shared to our subcontractors e.g., when necessary to provide our services or conduct our business operations such as for data storage. Medetect always ensures through personal processing agreements, or otherwise that our sub-processor only processes personal data with confidentiality and in accordance with this policy. If you, as a registered person, want to know which sub-processors are processing your personal data, you can contact us for information.

If the applicable law does not oblige us to do so, we will not disclose the above-mentioned data to third parties, unless it is necessary to execute your request. In cases where we need to disclose your information to third parties, you will be informed of this and we will request your consent.

How do we secure personal data?

Medetect employs reasonable physical, electronic, and managerial procedures for safeguard and secure the information from loss, misuse, unauthorized access or disclosure, alteration or destruction. Medetect cannot guarantee the security of information on or transmitted via the internet.

Medetect only processes personal data in a way that is compatible with and relevant for the purpose for which it was collected or authorized. To the extent necessary for those purposes,

Medetect takes reasonable measures to ensure that the personal data is accurate, complete, current, and reliable for its intended use.

Upon request, and as required by law, Medetect provides individuals reasonable access to provided personal data and allow individuals to correct, amend, or delete inaccurate information, except where the burden or expense of providing access would be disproportionate to the risk to the privacy of the individual in the case in question or where the rights of persons other than the individual would be violated.

How long is the information stored?

Information collected from you through a visit to our website or through a submitted request through our contact form, where you have accepted our privacy policy, or otherwise provided to us by email or phone communication, will remain with us until you ask to "unsubscribe" and delete the information. You can request unsubscribe at any time. If you do not choose to unsubscribe, we will store your personal data for as long as legally required by local laws or contractual obligations.

What is a cookie and how to manage your preferences

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your device when you visit a website. Cookies can be set by us ("first party cookies") or by third parties whose services we use ("third party cookies"). You can manage your preferences at any time through our cookie settings tool on the website.

How long are cookies stored

Cookie storage periods depend on the specific cookie. For example, our cookie declaration states that certain GA4 cookies may be stored for up to 400 days, while certain necessary cookies may be session based. You can also delete cookies manually via your browser settings.

Third party recipients and international transfers

Where we use Google services (Google Analytics 4 and Google reCAPTCHA), Google may act as a recipient of data. Some processing may involve transfers to countries outside the EU/EEA. We seek to ensure that appropriate safeguards are used for such transfers in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

Google reCAPTCHA (contact form protection)

To protect inquiries submitted through our online contact form and to distinguish humans from automated abuse (“bots”), we use Google’s reCAPTCHA service. This may involve sending your IP address and other data needed for reCAPTCHA to Google for processing. If IP anonymization is enabled, your IP address may be masked by Google within the EU/EEA; in exceptional cases the full IP address may be transferred to a server in the US and masked there. For more information, please refer to Google’s privacy information.

Google Analytics 4 (GA4 analytical cookies)

If you consent to analytical cookies, we use Google Analytics 4 (Google LLC) to collect aggregated statistics about website usage (e.g., page views, session information and interactions). This helps us improve our website. GA4 uses cookies such as “_ga” and “_ga_” with an expiration of up to 400 days (as stated in our cookie declaration). You can withdraw your consent at any time via our cookie settings tool; analytical cookies will then be removed from your browser.

Overview of cookies used

A current list of cookies, their purpose, provider, and retention is available in our cookie declaration in the cookie settings tool.

You can allow or deny cookies by category using our cookie settings tool (“Allow all”, “Deny all”, “Save settings”). You can also change your choices at any time later. To document and manage your choices, our consent tool records your consent status (e.g., the categories you consented to), together with a consent identifier and date/time of consent.

Cookie settings and withdrawal of consent

When categories that have previously been allowed are disabled, cookies assigned to that category will be removed from your browser.
